### MEMBERSHIP

Starting in March 2024 NRF Range Membership will be managed through www.Practiscore.com/clubs/nrf\_club. This will allow us to send mass notices to club/range members. Practiscore is also the platform used for registering for any events hosted by NRF. All club/range fees will come due on March 1<sup>st</sup> each year. Members who have annual memberships paid through a later month will get a prorated membership next time they renew. The following full one-year membership will be due the next March 1<sup>st</sup>. All new members throughout the year will join with a prorated membership through February 28<sup>th</sup> and will renew their membership again on the next March 1<sup>st</sup>.

Membership will have its privileges. Along with the use of the range I plan to have a NRF Club member cookout. This will be a time for fellowship relaxation and just to shoot the breeze, no pun intended, with likeminded shooters. It will likely be something simple like burgers and hotdogs but will be free to club members. We will do this after a match and non-club members will be invited but will be charged \$25 per plate.

Club members will have discounted competition fees. Every match in which you participate one gun will be discounted \$5. Club members will receive a 10% discount on all range store items. Anything in the retail store, guns, ammo, reloading supplies, or any miscellaneous items will be discounted 10% off the posted price. Any items you ask me to order, guns optics, parts, ammo, etc will be discounted 10% off my typical markup.

Gun transfer fees which are \$30 will be discounted \$10. So, a club member transfer will be \$20.

Annual Individual Membership (Annual fee: \$210.00) Annual Family membership (Annual fee: \$310.00, if one family member is a Patriot or Senior \$280) Must be dependent as defined on tax return.

**Senior membership** (Annual fee: \$180) 65 years old & over.

**Patriot Membership** (Annual fee: \$180), **Patriot Family Membership** (Annual fee: \$260-\$280) This membership is for an individual active-duty military or active first responder.

All member access is to access all ten shooting bays, The pistol bay behind the training venue and the 300-yard-long


range. Access allowed on weekdays and on weekends, weather permitting, and when not closed for competitions. For family Immediate family members only. Must be dependent as defined on tax return. Range hour 9:00 a.m. till 5:00 p.m. or 6:00 p.m. during DST.



#### THE RANGE

The plan for our affiliation with USPSA is to re-affiliate with USPSA but we plan to run hit factor or PCSL matches in the near future. We may run a USPSA match on Friday the day before a hit factor match with the same stages so we can meet our minimum match number to keep our affiliation status and let those who don't want to see support for USPSA to get their matches in. Regardless we at Natural Right Firearms will strive to provide the very best shooting experience we can. It is hard to believe a sanctioning body as established as USPSA will go away completely. Our goal is to host fun safe matches, whether it be PCSL, USPSA, IPSC or some other sanctioning body. Steel Challenge will be run just as before.

#### **CLASSES**



I am going to do an all-female basic firearms class. On Tuesday February 20<sup>th</sup> We have done this a couple times in the past and have had some calls to schedule one. #### Women's Basic Pistol

This section covers "What's your why?" Understanding Firearms, how to clear a semi-automatic, the universal safety rules for handguns. Every gun has a safety. What is it? We will learn basic shooting fundamentals. stance, grip sight alignment, sight picture trigger control breath control and follow through. We will work on proper stance and grip. We will

work on the most intimidating part of a semi-automatic for a female, racking the slide. Also, the hardest part of working a semi-automatic, loading a magazine. Then live fire shooting.

#### Women's Intermediate Pistol

This section will delve deeper into the fundamentals of firearms. It will look at the difference between revolvers and semiautomatics, the advantages, and disadvantages of each. We will discuss the weight differences and size differences of each. We will ask the question and determine which gun is right for you. In this section we will discuss

#### **BASIC HANDGUN**

COURSE LENGTH: 5 - 6 Hours Classroom and Live Fire COST: \$75.00

Ammunition, Bullets and Ballistics, cycles of gun operation. We will cover How you plan to carry, In a holster, inside the waistband, outside the waistband, underarm, bra or underarm, or leg (thigh or ankle). We will discuss situational awareness in this section.

We will conclude with putting some of the information learned in the class in action on the range. Drawing from the holster techniques, drawing from concealment, from a purse will be practiced on the range. We will learn how to practice with a purpose.
