I told the guys at the plant to drink two waters to 1 Gatorade.

SHOOTING CALENDAR

The July shooting calendar will be slowing down some. By the time you read this we will have just shot a very successful USPSA Classifier match. Now is a good time to announce Natural Right Firearms Range is going back to hosting all USPSA sanctioned matches. All the drama in USPSA seems to have died down some and It is nice to have a unified set of rules when we come to the range. We know USPSA rules, and the other disciplines are just not there yet. Hit factor matches are good but I have found people want the classification system USPSA has to offer.

We will be shooting steel Challenge on the 6th of July and August 3rd. We will not shoot any run and gun matches in July and August. It is just too hot. We have a full calendar for the fall and winter months, and there are plenty of ranges that will be shooting for you to get your fix. Brothers N Arms will be shooting their regular run n gun the first Sunday in July and the first Sunday in August. Biloxi will be shooting 3rd Sunday in July and August.

September will start to ramp up here at NRF. We will be shooting our normal Steel Challenge match, but it will be all 8 stages of steel Challenge. Usually, you only get this at a Level II or III match. There will not be the hype that goes along with a higher-level match, but you will get the practice from local competition, shoot all 8 classifier stages and bragging rights on Practiscore for \$25. We are doing this in September and October.

NRF range is hosting a Steve Anderson seminar which will be a three-day, Mental Management / Match coaching seminar. I think it is almost

completely booked so this is not an advertisement but if you're dying to be in his seminar shoot me a text or email and I'll get you in touch will Billy Herrington who is organizing the class. Our September USPSA match will be in addition to the match coaching class so if you sign up for that shoot you will at least get to meet Steve and get a feel for if you want to schedule more classes.

November is the target date for us though. NRF in conjunction with Masterpiece Arms is hosting our first State Championship Match. Registration begins today. That's right, the only Tier II steel challenge match in Mississippi this year. Because of the time constraints we will only run 6 stages and one bonus charity stage, but we have secured some great sponsors and look forward to hosting an awesome match for you the shooter.
