PANDEMIC / UNREST

GUN RANGE

Natural Right Firearms operates a small arm shooting range. At this time there is limited accessibility, one berm which can accommodate 4 shooters. Those who wish to use the range must be approved by Natural Right Firearms management.

Approval requires attending a range safety orientation, a signed affidavit of understanding and agreement to abide by range safety rules, and a signed Hold Harmless and Assumption of Risk Agreement.

TRAINING

Knowing your weapon can only be established by handling it. A lot. People never know how they will react in a critical dynamic incident until it happens. One of the best ways to guarantee failure is to never use your firearm until you must. When certifying for the enhanced carry endorsement you are required to only prove you can shoot a firearm safely. There is no stress. There is no ambush or shock value introduced in that training, yet people are usually uncomfortable shooting during that course. Think what it will be like if you or a loved one has their life on the line.

If you plan to carry a firearm, I want to encourage you to practice with that firearm. The hope most people I come across is that they would never have to use it. However, if you do you need to be proficient or it will cause more harm than good. Stay safe and be careful out there.
