### Membership Types

**Annual Individual Membership** (Annual fee: \$210.00) This membership is for an individual to access all six shooting bays, The pistol bay behind the training venue and the 300 yard long range. Access allowed weekdays and on weekends, weather permitted and when not closed for competitions.

**Annual Family membership** (Annual fee: \$295.00, if one family member is a Patriot or senior \$235.00) This membership is for a family access all six shooting bays, The pistol bay behind the training venue and the 300 yard long range. Immediate family members only. Must be a dependent as defined on tax return. Access allowed weekdays and on weekends, weather permitted and when not closed for competitions.

**Senior membership** (Annual fee: \$150) This membership is for an individual senior citizen to access all six shooting bays, The pistol bay behind the training venue and the 300 yard long range. Access allowed weekdays and on weekends, weather permitted and when not closed for competitions. 65 years old & over.

**Patriot Membership** (Annual fee: \$150), **Patriot Family Membership** (Annual fee: \$195) This membership is for an individual active duty military or first responder to access all six shooting bays, The pistol bay behind the training venue and the 300 yard long range. Active duty Military, Active duty first responders. Access allowed weekdays and on weekends, weather permitted and when not closed for competitions. For family Immediate family members only. Must be a dependent as defined on tax return.

## **Natural Right Firearms Range Rules**

Safety is **Your** responsibility! Every range attendee is expected to read, understand, and follow all range rules. All attendees are required to watch a brief safety video, read this Range Rules document and sign affirming understanding before being allowed attend the range. If you fail to adhere to these rules several options may be invoked such as reprimands, temporary suspension, or revocation of range privileges. We take safety very seriously and want to provide our guests with a safe and orderly environment that is conducive to learning and training.

### **Range Safety and Operation Rules**

Effective Date: January 1, 2021 These Range Rules are established to ensure the health and safety of everyone who uses the facilities as well as the community at large.

### **Fundamental Rules for Safe Gun Handling**

- **ALWAYS** keep the gun pointed in a safe direction.
- **ALWAYS** keep your finger off the trigger and outside the trigger guard until ready to shoot.
- **ALWAYS** keep the gun unloaded until ready to use on the range.
- Be sure of your target and what is beyond it.
- Know how to use the gun safely.
- Be sure the gun is safe to operate.
- Use only the correct ammunition for your gun.
- Store guns so they are not accessible to unauthorized persons.

### **GENERAL PROTOCOLS**

- The Club's facilities are operated as a "cold range." All exposed firearms may not contain any ammunition except when they are actively being used on a "hot" firing line inside of a shooting bay or the rifle range.
- All uncased firearms **MUST** have actions **OPEN** and **MAGAZINES REMOVED** unless the firearm is active on the firing line.
- If there are multiple shooters using a firing line or shooting bay at the same time, each shooter is limited to one bench and/or one lane.
- Targets must be directly in front of the shooter. No cross firing.
- Before a firing line or shooting bay is "cold," all shooters on the firing line or shooting bay must acknowledge the "cold" call. As shooters wearing hearing protection may not hear the command, double check to assure that all shooters on the firing line or shooting bay acknowledge the "cold" command. The firing line or shooting bay, however, is not fully "cold" until all shooters have properly secured their firearms by unloading them, removing all ammunition, leaving the breech open, engaging the safety, and then placing the firearm down (pistols may be holstered, bagged or boxed) on a shooting bench or shooting mat and stepping away from the firearms. Chamber safety flags should be used if available.
- When the firearm is properly secured and the shooter is away from the firearm, each shooter must call, "line clear." When all shooters acknowledge "line clear", the firing line or shooting bay is "cold" and shooters may proceed downrange to set or change targets.
- Firearms may not be touched or handled during "cold" range periods, no exceptions. Cased firearms may be unloaded from a vehicle at these times but must remain cased until the firing line or shooting bay goes "hot."
- When a shooter returns to the firing line or shooting bay area, he or she should shout "range clear" to indicate they are out of the active firing area. When all shooters are "range clear", it is "range hot." At this point, shooters may return to their firing positions and resume handling firearms.

## **ADMINISTRATIVE AND OPERATIONAL RULES**

### **General Rules for All Areas**

- The Natural Right Firearms shooting range facility is a private club and is accessible to members and their guests only.
- All firing lines and shooting bays will be kept open and available for usage by Club members in good standing, and their guests, as much of the time as is practical. Firing lines and shooting bays may be closed for special events and maintenance. These closures will be published on the Club's Internet web site or emailed to member's email address in as far in advance as is reasonably possible.
- During competitive matches or other similar events, one or more qualified Club members must serve as a Match Director / Safety Officer. Specific range rules may be modified by the Match Director as required for the event.
- Arrange targets so that bullets strike the impact berms after hitting the target. ALL SHOTS FIRED MUST REMAIN ON CLUB PROPERTY.
- Members must wear their membership cards in a manner that is always visible to other members when on the range.
- Hours of operation are 9:00 am to 6:00 pm Monday-Saturday during DST and Sunday 1:00 pm until 5:00 pm. Hours of operation are 9:00 am to 5:00 pm Monday-Saturday during non-DST and Sunday 1:00 pm until 5:00 pm.

### **The following are always specifically prohibited at the range:**

1. Use or consumption of alcoholic beverages.
2. Possession of illegal or recreational drugs.
3. Usage of fully automatic firearms.
4. Tracer, incendiary ammunition, armor piercing or penetrator rounds.
5. Tannerite or any other type of exploding, reactive or moving target.
6. "Bump" firing, "quick draw/fast draw" and "instinct" firing.
7. Drawing from a shoulder holster.
8. Cans, bottles, and/or plastic containers as well as fruits, vegetables, and other organic matter as targets.
9. 50 cal. BMG or other calibers of comparable kinetic force.
10. "Horseplay" of any kind at any time.
11. Any comments or behaviors a member may reasonably interpret as belligerent, hostile or threatening.
12. Offensive targets such as those depicting pictures or images of elected officials and/or prominent people, religious or ethnic imagery, etc.

### **General Prohibitions**

- No hunting is allowed on range property.
- Members may bring non-member guests each visit for a fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25). Guests must sign in and provide a state issued Identification card to the staff at the range house. The member assumes responsibility for the actions of their guests while at the Club and guests must always stay with the member.
- Small vehicles such as golf carts, ATVs, and similar may be driven into any "downrange" area as long as the range is "cold." Passenger or other vehicles may not be driven into any "downrange" area except as authorized by an event organizer to facilitate event setup or teardown.
- Club target frames are provided for member convenience. Targets should be mounted to the frames so that bullets impacting the targets do not also impact the target frames. Target frames should be at sufficient height so that rounds passing through the target impact the berm at the far end of the range.
- Only Club owned target frames might be stored in Club facilities. If you bring a target frame, you must take it with you when you leave.
- Anyone under the age of eighteen (18) must always be accompanied by an adult member or other range-authorized adult.
- No children under the age of seven are permitted to use the range.
- Do not shoot the frames. We assess a replacement fee for any broken frames.
- All firearms must be in a case or worn holstered on strong side to enter Main Range. Gun socks and scabbards will not be allowed as substitutes.

- Tracers, incendiary, explosive, specialty shot shells, and other similar rounds are strictly prohibited.
- Any firearms chambered in .50 BMG, or any round derived from .50 BMG, or producing kinetic force on par with .50 BMG is strictly prohibited.
- Anyone under the influence of alcohol or impaired in any way will not be permitted to shoot.
- Firearms must be cased and uncased at the shooting tables only, with the muzzles pointed down range.
- The only steel or reactive targets permitted on ranges are those belonging to the Club. Member-owned metal or reactive targets are not permitted unless approved by the range owners.
- The Club requires that eye and ear protection be worn by all persons in a firing line or shooting bay or within proximity to a firing line or shooting bay.
- Every member is responsible for cleaning up his or her area after firing. All center-fire metallic cartridges and shotshells must be picked up as well as any other trash such as empty food packaging, beverage containers, ammunition boxes, etc. Please be sure the lid is properly secured to the container when you put it back on.
- When not actively shooting, secure and store your firearms so they are not accessible to anyone else.

### **Specific Rules for Pistol Bays**

- Pistol Bays may only be used for pistol or pistol caliber rifle, and rim-fire rifle (.22 LR and lower calibers) shooting.
- Shotguns may not be used with club provided target frames at any time. You must bring your own frame to use with shotguns.
- All targets must always be set up so that rounds impact the backstop berms only; there are no exceptions.
- Target center-of-mass may be no more than 5'5" (65") above the flat ground level of the pistol bay in use.

### **Specific Rules for Rifle Range**

- The only allowable distances for shooting on the Rifle Range are 25, 50, 100, 150, 200 & 300 yards. You must use only the shooting benches that line up with the appropriate yardage. **NO CROSSFIRING.**
- NO pistols or shotguns are to be used on the Rifle Range.
- NO shots may be made on the Rifle Range while standing. All shots must be made while sitting, kneeling or prone.
- Rapid fire shooting on the Rifle Range is not allowed. There must be a minimum of a 3 second gap between each shot.
- Target frames should be at sufficient height so that rounds passing through the target impact the designated backstop berms. Adjust target frames as necessary to achieve the desired height to assure bullets strike the berm.
- Only paper targets are to be used on the rifle range. Club owned metal targets may be used at the 300 Yard distance.

### **VIOLATION OF RULES**

Violation of these rules may subject the violator to disciplinary action. This may include expulsion from the Natural Right Firearms Facility and/or criminal charges may result if the situation dictates, they are appropriate.

### **Hold Harmless, and Assumption of Risk Agreement**

WHEREAS, in return for instruction in firearms, use of premises, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt, and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Undersigned agrees to the following: The Undersigned agrees to indemnify, hold harmless and defend DeSoto Enterprises LLC DBA Natural Right Firearms (hereinafter referred to as "Natural Right Firearms"); and any of its employees, directors, officers or agent, from any and all fault, liabilities, costs, expenses, claims,

demands or lawsuits arising out of, related to or connected with: the discharge of firearms; the course of instruction; the Undersigned's participation in the course of instruction; the range, buildings, land and premises used for the course of instruction (hereinafter the "Premises"); the Undersigned's presence on or use of said Premises; and any and all acts or omissions of the Undersigned. And should any such claim, demand or lawsuit arise or be asserted in any way whatsoever related thereto, whether arising under the laws of the United States or of any State, or under any theory of law or equity, the Undersigned will indemnify, hold harmless and defend the Natural Right Firearms Training, from any and all costs, expenses or liability including, but not limited to, the cost of any settlement or judgment made or rendered against the Natural Right Firearms Training, whether individually, jointly, or in solido with the Undersigned, together with all costs of court and other costs or expenses incurred in connection with any such claim, demand or lawsuit, including attorney's fees.

The Undersigned furthermore waives for himself/herself and his/her executors, administrators, assignees or heirs, any and all rights and claims for damages, losses, demands and any other actions whatsoever, which he/she may have or which may arise against the Natural Right Firearms, (including, but not limited to any and all injuries, damages or illnesses suffered by the Undersigned or the Undersigned's property), which may, in any way whatsoever, arise out of, be related to or be connected with: the course of instruction; the Premises, including any latent defect in the Premises; the Undersigned's presence on or use of said Premises; the Undersigned's property (whether or not entrusted to the Natural Right Firearms Training); and the discharge of firearms. Natural Right Firearms shall not be liable for, and the Undersigned, on behalf of himself/herself and his/her executors, administrators, assignees or heirs, hereby expressly releases the Natural Right Firearms from any and all such claims.

The Undersigned hereby expressly assumes the risk of entering the Premises and of taking part in activities on the Premises which include, but are not limited to, instruction in the use of firearms, the discharge of firearms and the firing of live ammunition.

The Undersigned furthermore hereby acknowledges and agrees that he/she has read, understands and will at all times abide by all range rules and procedures.

This instrument binds the Undersigned and his / her executors, administrators, assignees, or heirs.
